I would like to share a brief update regarding **email communication**. We would like to remind families of our school policy regarding **jewellery during PE lessons**. For health and safety reasons, **children must not wear earrings or any other jewellery during PE**. This is in line with national safety guidance and helps to prevent injury to your child and others. Please note:

- Earrings **must be removed at home on PE days**
- Staff are **not permitted to remove or cover earrings with tape**
- If earrings cannot be removed, your child may be unable to take part fully in the PE lesson

We understand that this can be inconvenient, particularly for children with newly pierced ears. If this is the case, we advise arranging piercings at the **start of the summer holidays**, allowing sufficient time for healing before returning to school. Thank you for your support in helping us keep all children safe during physical activity.

We hope the **diary dates overview** is helpful and please also take a moment to read any **class-specific emails** carefully so your child is fully organised.
